



What Do I Bring to the Test Session?



IF NOT CURRENTLY LICENSED, YOU NEED TO BRING

- Your Social Security Number (SSN) or your FCC Registration Number (FRN).
- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- If you previously held a General, Advanced, or Amateur Extra license that expired more than 2 years ago, proof that you held the license. (See below.)
- Pen for filling out the application.
- Pencil for marking the test answer sheet. (You can use a pen if you are REALLY confident!)

IF UPGRADING AN EXISTING LICENSE, YOU NEED TO BRING

- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- Proof of your current license. (See below.)
- The original and a photocopy of any CSCE's showing credit for elements already passed but not reflected in your current license.
- If you previously held a General, Advanced, or Amateur Extra license that expired more than 2 years ago, proof that you held the license. (See below.)
- Pen for filling out the application.
- Pencil for marking the test answer sheet. (You can use a pen if you are REALLY confident!)

IF MODIFYING OR RENEWING AN EXISTING LICENSE, YOU NEED TO BRING

- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- Proof of your current license. (See below.)
- Pen for filling out the application.

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF CURRENT OR EXPIRED LICENSE

Current license or license expired less than 2 years ago:

- Original license printed by the FCC on watermarked paper.
- Official copy of license printed on plain paper with the words "Official Copy" printed diagonally across the page.
- Reference copy of license printed on plain paper with the words "Reference Copy" printed diagonally across the page.

License expired more than 2 years ago:

- Original license printed by the FCC.
- Photocopy of original license.
- Reference copy of license printed from the ULS with the words "Reference Copy" printed diagonally across the page.
- Letter from FCC confirming license.
- Photocopy of cover & applicable page from an issue of the *Callbook* showing the date of publication, the applicant's name, call sign, and class of license.
