




Class Procedures

- Class dismissal time will vary depending on material covered.








After the Class

- Make note of any material or questions that you do not understand so that you can ask questions at the start of the next class.



- General class license focuses on HF and advanced modes.






The General Class License & Amateur Radio

- Currently 3 classes of amateur radio operator license being granted:
 - Technician Class
 - General Class.
 - Amateur Extra Class.
- Each class gives access to more operating privileges.







The General Class License & Amateur Radio


Morse Code


- Part of amateur radio from the beginning.
- No longer required for any class amateur radio operator license.
- Although no longer needed for license, use of CW among new operators is steadily increasing.
- Several on-line & software resources available for learning the code.








